

2024 AIRE Rapid Grand Prix

RULES

1. Teams can use their highest 4 finishes of the 6 events offered for the overall AIRE RGP series points title.
2. R2 teams can use 1 alternate, or, 3 total paddlers for the AIRE RGP series points title.
3. R4 teams can use 2 alternates, or, 6 total paddlers for the AIRE RGP series points title. 2 of these persons must be in the boat at each race for the points to count towards the series.
4. In the event of a tie a head to head post race “paddle off” at event 6 will determine the overall AIRE RGP series winner. The terms of the paddle off will be determined by the RGP series coordinator.
5. All participants are required to attend the safety meetings before each event or have at least one team member do so.
6. For each race, 1st = 4 points. 2nd = 2 points. 3rd = 1 point.
7. Participants of the AIRE RGP are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, community, family friendly, and/or child safe manner at all times which include in person and social media communication both before, after, and during the events. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification at the discretion of the RGP series coordinator.
8. In the event of a protest or concern the series coordinator will refer to International Rafting Federation (IRF) rules for guidance.

CLASSES

- Kayak 10 feet and under.
- R2 raft any length, round boats only no shredders
- R4 raft any length, round boats only no shredders
