

## BACK to the CLACK

### May 14, 2022 (Saturday)

9am – ALL participants meet at the Memaloose Weigh Station to carpool to Moore Creek put in. Please carpool!

We will hand out bib numbers and sign liability waivers here. If online registration doesn't max out there may be an opportunity to do in person registration here.

10:30am – Moore Creek river access.

Trucks and trailers provided for transport to the Hole in the Wall put in will swing through in case you missed Memaloose. Don't miss Memaloose! Parking at Moore Creek is VERY LIMITED.

11am – Unload and stage your boats on the beach at the Hole in the Wall put in (Milepost 41).

11:15am all boater's safety meeting.

11:30am- Safety boats depart to Hole in the Wall, river right after ledge at Carter Rapid, river left eddy 1<sup>st</sup> corner past Carter Bridge.

AIRE Rapid Grand Prix points race!

HIGH NOON

Kayaks 10 feet and under mass start.

12:10 – R2 Rafts mass start. AIRE Rapid Grand Prix points race.

12:15 – All remaining boats depart.  
RACE finish line is river right in the big eddy in the corner just below Carter Bridge.

After finishing continue floating downstream to Big Eddy, stage here river right for the next race stage.

1:15 Safety boats depart to stage river left below Rock and Roll and Toilet Bowl.

1:30pm – R4 raft mass start sprint to river right rock just below Toilet Bowl.

AIRE Rapid Grand Prix points race!

- R2 crews combine to make an R4 and put one of your rafts on the shuttle trailer.
- Kayakers hop in a raft to make an R4 team!! If you do put your boat on a shuttle vehicle.

1:40pm – ALL other boats mass start for the fun race to Moore Creek.

2:30pm – Moore Creek take out river right, or if you have parked at Memaloose continue down to your vehicle. Load all boats for shuttle back to Estacada.

4:30pm – Awards and videos at: Trails Inn Café and Timber Room. 397 S Broadway St. Estacada Oregon 97023. Minors can utilize the tables outside. Alcoholic drinks must stay on premises. Discounted beers from Deschutes Brewing! Clackamas River Outfitters will be open for browsing.

1. Race entry will be online and limited to the first 60 signups starting May2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.
